

## COVID 19

Following further clarification of the Government plan to ease lockdown restrictions, we have now resumed our facility hire. As a British Showjumping affiliated venue, in light of guidance received from British Showjumping we will also be running training competitions as from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020. We are not yet permitted to run residential camps and will keep you updated as and when more guidance is received about the practicality of running these.

Booking and payment for hire of all facilities must be done via our website at [www.coxleigh.com](http://www.coxleigh.com). The facilities may be hired for individual use or you may meet with one other from outside your household which may be a coach or other participant, with the proviso that the appropriate social distancing and hygiene practices are in place. Coaches must ensure that the necessary measures, risk assessments and safeguarding provisions are put in place, including checking insurance cover with their providers. Those travelling to and from Coxleigh must all be from the same household.

### Hire of arenas and tracks

When you arrive, please park in one of the clearly marked out parking bays that have been measured to ensure safe social distancing between clients. Sanitising facilities are available outside the mobile homes and outside the arena gates. Please do not unload until you are ready to ride. Sanitise your hands and put on gloves. PLEASE NOTE YOU WILL EXPECTED TO PROVIDE YOUR OWN GLOVES. Please then set up the arena for your session and when you have finished setting up your course, discard your gloves in the bin provided outside the arena. YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TOUCH ANY EQUIPMENT IN THE ARENA UNLESS GLOVES ARE WORN.

When you have set up the arena, you may unload, tack up and complete your session. Access to the 50 x 70 arena is down the slope and through the main gate which must be left open. Access to the 20 x 60 arena is via the small gate at the top of the slope which must also remain open. When you have finished your session, please ensure that you clear any poo in the arena or car park by using the scoops provided, sanitising them first using the spray provided.

Our booking system allows 30 mins before and after your session to set up before your session and untack afterwards. Please make sure you strictly adhere to your time slot.

### Hire of XC course

Parking for the XC course is clearly signposted; turn left down the track at the end of the drive and park on the hard standing area in the XC field.

Hand sanitiser is provided just inside the gateway to the field.

In the event that there is another individual on the XC course, please ensure you adhere to social distancing guidelines and choose a different area on the XC course to school.

The steps complex on the course will remain closed due to its proximity to liveries on site.

**Please note that there is NO ACCESS TO ANY OTHER FACILITIES on site, including the mobile homes, yards, hose pipes, water or toilet facilities. There is also no provision for First Aid to be administered on site, and accordingly, we ask that you make sure that you ride sensibly during your session and within both yours and your horses' capability.
