## <u>Using Facilities at Coxleigh Barton – Disclaimer</u>

- All horses attending camp must be fully vaccinated
- No persons may ride on the Cross Country course alone.
- Body protectors adhering to current British Standards must be worn at all times whilst mounted when using the Cross country course.
- Current safety standard riding hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted and whilst handling Horses.
- Any damage caused to a Cross Country fence, show jump or any property must be reported to the instructor and office.
- Riders deemed to be riding dangerously will be asked to dismount and leave the course or the arena.
- All droppings must be removed immediately from the arena and public areas.
- Any accidents must be reported and an accident form completed in the office.
- I understand there may be chance to go on an escorted hack. Coxleigh
  will provide an escort purely on a directional basis to ensure you do not
  get lost and to provide you with some information about the area in
  which you are riding. They will not be a qualified instructor so cannot
  offer any form or instruction or assistance during the ride. Riders ride
  entirely at their own risk. Coxleigh will assume no liability for any
  accidents or injuries sustained when hacking.

## The Horse Rider's Code of Conduct

- I understand that riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions.
- I may fall off and could be injured. I accept that risk.
- I understand that instructions are given for my safety and I agree the instructions must be followed. I understand that if I refuse to follow such instructions, I may be asked to leave the camp.
- I understand that wearing an appropriate riding hat and body protector may reduce the severity of an injury should an accident happen and agree that I will always wear a riding hat whilst riding and handling my horse.
- I understand that competing carries enhanced risk over and above general riding and agree that if I chose to participate in any competition or event, there is a risk of injury in the event of an accident.
- I accept it is my responsibility to provide an equine first aid kit for the duration of my stay at Coxleigh Barton.
- I accept that it is my responsibility to inform the organisers/staff members of Coxleigh Barton of any vices or behavioural issues inherent in the Horse I will be riding, and to advise if I need assistance in any particular aspect of caring for my horse whilst staying at Coxleigh Barton.

Use of the equestrian facilities at Coxleigh Barton are carried out at entirely your own risk. No liability will be accepted for any injury, loss or damage suffered, whether occasioned by the negligence or breach of contract statutory duty of the

owners, their servants, agents, employees or those connected with the Equestrian facilities. We advise that every rider holds public liability and personal insurance.

I consent to receiving any medical treatment, which, in the opinion of a qualified first aider, may be necessary.

## **Residential Camp - Terms & Conditions:**

- All bookings require a £50 non refundable deposit at time of booking. Places will
  not be held without the deposit being paid. Payment details: please pay a £50
  deposit at the time of booking to secure your place. A place will not be
  reserved for you until this is received. Please make payments by BACS to
  Messrs M E & J Gay sort code 30 90 49, Account no 37834068
- Balances must be paid in full by no later than 6 weeks before the camp. Non payment will result in cancellation of your place.
- Cancellations made 28 days or more prior to your camp will be issued a full refund, less deposit.
- Cancellations made between 28 and 7 days prior to camp will be issued a 50% refund, less deposit, unless the space can be filled, then a full refund, less deposit, will be made.
- Cancellation of 7 days or less prior to camp, there will be no refund unless in special circumstances. A vet certificate will be requested and refunds in these circumstances are entirely at the discretion of the organiser and may incur an additional administration fee.
- The instructors may refuse to allow any person to take part if they have any doubt about the safety of a person due to capability, faulty tack/equipment or any other reason until they are satisfied with the amendments made.
- If a camp organised by Coxleigh Barton Equestrian Centre has to be cancelled for reasons beyond our control then the rider will be offered a full refund or the option to carry forward their payment to another date, space permitting.
