## Membership Terms & Conditions

- All facilities must be booked in advance after checking availability on the website. Bookings can be made via email to [jo@coxleigh.com](mailto:jo@coxleigh.com)
- Arena use is limited to a maximum of 1 hour per week. Membership entitles member to use the 20x60 arena only. Only the member is entitled to use the arena for free, if a member brings a non member guest they must pay the appropriate arena hire fee stated on our website.

Additional charges apply for:

Use of arena lights £3 an hour

Hire of mounted games equipment £5

- Members are entitled to use the 50x70 arena at a reduced rate of £12.50 per hour. This offer is only for the member, other users in the arena must pay the full fee even if with a member.
- Members are entitled to unlimited but not exclusive use of the cross-country paddock and tracks during the dates these facilities are available for public hire. Members must follow the specific rules stated by Coxleigh for when using the cross-country paddock and tracks. Members guests must book and pay for the facilities in advance & sign a disclaimer.
- A responsible adult must accompany junior members at all times. Coxleigh takes no responsibility for any child whilst using the facilities included in their membership.
- Members are not entitled to any form of discount on any camps, junior days, lessons, clinics or events held at or by Coxleigh unless stated on the event information.
- Only members can use the facilities provided by their membership free of charge. Guests and Non-members must book and pay for all facility use, even if accompanied by a member, unless agreed otherwise in writing by Coxleigh.
- Payment in instalments- first payment of 50% upfront followed by second instalment on 1st June. Late payments will result in revoked membership.
- Coxleigh will not tolerate bullying, bad sportsmanship, bad behaviour/language or any form of cruelty. Safety/welfare of the child & Horse is of paramount importance.
- Coxleigh reserves the right to refuse or terminate membership.

### Using Facilities at Coxleigh Barton – Disclaimer:

1. No persons under the age of 18 may use the cross-country paddock unless accompanied by an adult. No persons may ride the course alone.
2. No persons under the age of 18 can ride on the tracks unless accompanied by an adult.
3. Back/Body protectors adhering to current British Standards must be worn at all times whilst mounted when using the cross-country paddock and the tracks if jumping.
4. Current safety standard riding hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted and whilst handling ponies when on site at Coxleigh.
5. Any damage caused to a cross country fence, show jump or any equipment/property must be reported immediately.
6. Riders deemed to be riding dangerously, will be asked to leave the venue.
7. All droppings must be removed immediately from the arena and public areas.
8. Any accidents/incidents must be reported and an accident/incident form completed in the office.
9. All members using the facilities must hold personal and public liability insurance. You must be able to provide a copy of this up on request.
10. There are various logs, open ditches and other jumpable obstructions along the tracks. These can be easily bypassed. Should you choose to jump them you do so entirely at your own risk. By choosing to jump these obstructions you have deemed them safe to do so. Coxleigh do not take responsibility for servicing and maintaining any of the jumpable objects or natural obstructions on the tracks.

### The Horse Rider's Code of Conduct

- I understand that riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions.
- My child may fall off and could be injured. I accept that risk.
- I understand that instructions are given for the safety of my child and agree the instructions must be followed.
- I understand that wearing an appropriate riding hat and body protector may reduce the severity of an injury should an accident happen and agree

that my child will always wear a riding hat whilst riding and handling their horse when at Coxleigh.

- I understand that children are at particular risk around horses and agree that I will keep any children that I am responsible for, under close supervision.
- I understand that competing carries enhanced risk over and above general riding and agree that if I chose to allow my child to participate in any competition or event, there is a risk of injury in the event of an accident.
- I accept that it is my responsibility to inform the organisers/staff members of Coxleigh Barton of any vices or behavioural issues inherent in the pony my child will be riding, and to advise if my child needs assistance in any particular aspect of caring for their pony whilst at Coxleigh Barton.

Use of the equestrian facilities at Coxleigh Barton are carried out at entirely your own risk. No liability will be accepted for any injury, loss or damage suffered, whether occasioned by the negligence or breach of contract statutory duty of the owners, their servants, agents, employees or those connected with the Equestrian facilities.
